Sunscreen Policy

MBCPR sunscreen policy is to do everything possible to protect our campers from excessive exposure to the sun, while still allowing them to get the most out of our outdoor games, trips and activities.



Families are responsible for applying the **first** layer of sunscreen prior to morning drop-off and provide it for use during the camp day. Sunscreen should be placed in a sealed plastic bag and labeled with the child's first and last name and be readily accessible in the child's bag throughout the day.

During the camp day, staff will take all reasonable and appropriate steps to help remind each child reapply sunscreen to exposed skin— including the face, the tops of ears, and bare shoulders, arms, legs, & feet— prior to campers' participation in outdoor programs.
