



The Martinsburg-Berkeley County Parks & Recreation Board is pleased to present the BB&T Quad State Basketball Classics Youth Basketball Tournaments. Games will be played at BOTH the Berkeley 2000 Recreation Center at Lambert Park (accessed off Woodbury Avenue.) in Martinsburg, WV and the W. Randy Smith Recreation Center (beside Musselman High School) in Inwood, WV.

The tournaments will be held on the following dates:

We will work within reason to accommodate scheduling conflicts. Each team will be guaranteed a minimum of 3 games with an entry fee of **\$200 per team/per tournament** for all divisions. **The divisions include:**

Teams are required to have identical colored jerseys with numbers on the front and back.

GAME RULES

NFHS RULES WILL APPLY IN ALL SITUATIONS EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- All divisions will play **four 6-minute quarters** with the exception of **Grades 9-12**; quarters will be 7 minutes in length.
- **Overtime** (in all divisions) will be **3 minutes** in length.
- Each team will have **two full**, and **two 30 second** time-outs. One additional timeout will be awarded to each team if play goes to overtime.
- Once play has reached **the 4th Quarter**, if a team leads by 20 or more points, the clock will continue to run except when the follow takes place: a time out is taken, a technical foul is given, or an injury occurs.
- All rosters must be solidified by START of FIRST game.
- Up to **two** players per team (**within the same organization**) may play on a **maximum of two rosters** given they are the correct age/grade.
- Teams that are late will have a **10 minute grace period**, after the official game time to arrive. At that time they must have 5 legal players to start the game or they will have to **forfeit**.
- Teams (all divisions) may press full-court the entire length of the game.
- If a player receives **two unsportsmanlike technical fouls** in a game, they will be disqualified for the remainder of that game and must sit out the next game of the tournament. If a player or coach receives a total of **three unsportsmanlike technical fouls** within our tournament, they will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament and the entire following tournament, if registered to play or coach.
- **Tiebreak rule**—After pool play completed, the head to head record will determine bracket seeding. Fewest points by opponents will determine seeding if head to head record cannot determine seeding.



2019 GRADE/AGE ELIGIBILITY

Players must be in the proper grade level or below with the following birthdate requirements:

12th Graders	born on or after	9/1/99
11th Graders	born on or after	9/1/00
10th Graders	born on or after	9/1/01
9th Graders	born on or after	9/1/02
8th Graders	born on or after	9/1/03
7th Graders	born on or after	9/1/04
6th Graders	born on or after	9/1/05
5th Graders	born on or after	9/1/06
4th Graders	born on or after	9/1/07

EXCEPTION—If 'play down a grade division' age requirements are met as follows:**

<u>Grade as of 9/1/18</u>	<u>Play Down Grade</u>	<u>Birthdate Requirement</u>
12th Grade	11th Grade	born on or after 9/1/01
11th Grade	10th Grade	born on or after 9/1/02
10th Grade	9th Grade	born on or after 9/1/03
9th Grade	8th Grade	born on or after 9/1/04
8th Grade	7th Grade	born on or after 9/1/05
7th Grade	6th Grade	born on or after 9/1/06
6th Grade	5th Grade	born on or after 9/1/07
5th Grade	4th Grade	born on or after 9/1/08

**** Any team with a player wishing to play down must present a birth certificate before play begins.**
